

ORDINANCE NO. 2000-03

AN ORDINANCE FIXING THE REGULAR MEETING DATE AND PLACE OF CITY COUNCIL MEETINGS OF THE CITY OF HEBRON ESTATES, BULLITT COUNTY, KENTUCKY.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Hebron Estates, Bullitt County, Kentucky had previously by Ordinance established the regular date for City Council meetings as the fourth (4th) Tuesday of each month;

WHEREAS, due to a change in circumstances and the inconvenience which was created by meeting at this late date each month;

WHEREAS, this dislocation of the operation of City government has resulted in inconvenience to the City, City Council, and general public, and

WHEREAS, Kentucky State Statutes require the date of regular City Council meetings to be established by ordinance so as to adequately inform the public of the time when the public's business is performed, now, therefore;

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HEBRON ESTATE, BULLITT COUNTY, KENTUCKY, does hereby ordain as follows:

SECTION ONE: The regular monthly meeting of the City Council of the City of Hebron Estates, Bullitt County, Kentucky, shall be on the first Tuesday night of each month at 7:00 p.m. at North Bullitt High School Library, 3200 East Hebron Lane, Shepherdsville, Bullitt County, Kentucky.

SECTION TWO: This Ordinance shall become effective for the regular monthly meeting in August, 2000.

SECTION THREE: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this Ordinance or any part of this Ordinance are repealed.

SECTION FOUR: Should any section, clause, line, paragraph, or part of this Ordinance be held unconstitutional or invalid for any reason, the same shall not affect the remainder of this Ordinance.

Given second reading, voted upon and passed at the regular meeting of the City Council of the City of Hebron Estates, Bullitt County, Kentucky, the 27th day of June, 2000.
